Holidays For All!

Created by the French State Secretariat for Tourism, the Tourisme & Handicap label is part of a voluntary approach and is intended for all tourist sites and facilities in the country.

Totally free of charge, it enables us to qualify our tourist offer for disabled customers, for all 4 types of disability (motor, visual, hearing and mental).



This label represents a major opportunity to improve the accessibility of our tourist destinations, and of our accommodation and leisure facilities in particular.

For tourism professionals, having the label means maintaining a competitive advantage for the tourism potential represented by the disabled population.

The town of La Ciotat is making every effort in terms of development to meet these requirements.

La Ciotat Tourist Office and Provence Tourisme are partners in implementing the TOURISME & HANDICAP label program in the Bouches-du-Rhône region.

To be certified, the structure or activity must meet very strict admissibility criteria and have been visited by official bodies – the only ones qualified to award the label.



However, we have listed a number of sectors below which have answered our questions and which – pending certification – can offer certain services for this disabled public.

ADMINISTRATION



TOURIST OFFICE

The Tourist Office has been awarded the "Tourisme & Handicap" label for 4 disabilities (motor, hearing, mental and visual).

Our reception staff have received appropriate and mandatory training to deal with this public.

The reception area has been refurbished to welcome disabled persons in optimum comfort.

A notice board lists all certified or accessible local services.

A magnetic loop and magnifying glass are available to visitors, should they need them.



A document presenting local services in terms of accommodation and leisure activities that have been approved or are accessible to disabled persons has been published to meet the needs of this type of public.

A document in Braille and large print presenting certified or accessible services for disabled persons, and a map of the city centre in Braille locating accessible and/or certified places, are available for consultation on request.

A new automatic sliding entrance door has been installed, along with warning strips.

A guiding strip has been installed in the reception area to make it easier for visually impaired visitors to get around.

If necessary, masks with transparent windows are worn by reception staff to facilitate lip-reading and make facial expressions visible.

The Musée du Vieux La Ciotat is a museum of art and tradition.

It tells the story of the town's heritage and the traditions of Provence. Exhibitions and guided tours are set up throughout the year.

Persons with reduced mobility can only access the rooms and exhibitions on the 1st floor (with a step to climb), via rue Adolphe Abeille.

NOTRE DAME DE L'ASSOMPTION CHURCH

17th-century church. A visit is a must. Restored some fifteen years ago, the traditional main altar has been preserved. Its originality lies in the wall paintings decorating the church and the layout of the bays, in contrasting styles.

THEATRE DE LA CHAUDRONNERIE

Dedicated parking spaces are reserved for persons with reduced mobility. Reservations must be made with the ticketing service, at the ticket office or by telephone. Please arrive at least 30 minutes before the performance. Both rooms are equipped with a magnetic loop. Please report to reception on arrival. Certified for all 4 disabilities.

EDEN THEATRE

The Eden is the world's oldest surviving cinema. Completely renovated and awarded the "Tourisme et Handicap" label for 4 disabilities (mental, motor, hearing and visual), it can now accommodate persons with reduced mobility. It has a screening room on the first floor with 5 wheelchair spaces.



A balcony screening room with 2 wheelchair spaces. A lift is available for access to the upper floor. An access ramp has been installed in the courtyard. 2 accessible washrooms, with right- or left-hand transfer. A personal welcome is also available.

YACHTING



HANDIPLAGE

La Plage Lumière has been awarded the "Tourisme et Handicap" label (for all four disabilities: motor, hearing, mental and visual).

Showers, changing rooms, lockers and toilets are available for persons with disabilities.

At Plage Lumière, nine Tiralos and two Hippocampes wheelchairs with a motorised lifting system for transferring wheelchairs provide access to the beach and bathing for persons with reduced mobility, free of charge and subject to reservation.

In season, municipal staff are on hand to help bathers access the beach.

Adapted equipment (hoist for launching boats, lift for boarding PRMs) and the simplicity of this gear make it accessible to all. It can be manoeuvred with a steering wheel or a rudder, and can be adapted to any disability.

LEISURE & NATURE



LES JARDINS DE L'ESPERANCE

In a park of almost 3,700m² belonging to the town, the Jardins de l'Espérance offer a wide range of activities linked to the environment and gardening.

They have been awarded the "Tourisme & Handicap" label (for hearing, visual, mental disabilities), and their aim is to create educational gardens, promoting the inclusion of disabled or sick children within educational workshops for all.

4 goals have been set:

- Preserving a natural area in the middle of an urbanised site as a refuge for easily observable small fauna and Mediterranean flora.
- Offering a natural space to children (school groups or leisure) to allow them to discover the environment and raise their awareness of nature conservation.



- Integrating disabled or sick children into this natural environment to help them flourish.
- Offering a place of activity for adults with disabilities, in groups or individually, to discover nature and enjoy gardening.

L'ATELIER BLEU – CPIE CÔTE PROVENCALE

Based in the Parc du Mugel, Atelier Bleu – CPIE Côte Provençale has been developing activities for the general public for over 35 years. Around 13,000 people benefit from its activities every year.

The water- and land-based activities developed by Atelier Bleu – CPIE Côte provençale – are designed to allow visitors to discover the diversity of coastal landscapes in complete safety, to raise public awareness of the fragility of ecosystems, and to encourage and support behavioural changes.

To help persons with disabilities take part in these activities, Atelier Bleu has developed teaching aids adapted to different forms of disability, and trained its nature and sports instructors.

The discovery of the Port d'Alon underwater trail in St Cyr sur Mer (83), accompanied by a state-certified diving eco-guide, is accessible to all persons with disabilities, in small numbers, and in particular to persons with reduced mobility, thanks to facilities offering access to the water.

The discovery of the Mugel underwater trail in La Ciotat, accompanied by a state-certified diving eco-guide instructor, is accessible to persons with sensory disabilities.



Some of the nature walks are also accessible to persons with sensory or mental disabilities; the guided tour of the Parc du Mugel and the guided tour of small-scale fishing are accessible to all types of disabilities.

For all these activities, the financial participation required is equivalent to that of the able-bodied public. For groups, please contact them.

L'Atelier Bleu has also created sound walks in partnership with the Parc national des Calanques, for able-bodied and visually-impaired visitors to the Carrière du Loin site in La Ciotat and the Fontaine de Voire site in Marseilles. The walks can be downloaded free of charge from the My Calanques app.

LA VOIE DOUCE

The Voie Douce crosses the city from the centre to the outlying districts and Bastide Marin. Entirely pedestrianised, the Voie Douce is accessible to persons with reduced mobility thanks to specially adapted passageways. This 5.4 km path, entirely planted and secured, was laid out on the route of a former railway track.

PROMENADE LITTORALE

Almost 3 kilometres long, the Promenade Littorale (Coastal Walk) links the small port of St Jean with the Port Vieux in the city centre.

This walkway is fully equipped to allow persons with disabilities to move safely along the beaches – including the Tourisme & Handicap labelled Plage Lumière.

Parking spaces for the public in question can be found throughout this walk.

Restaurants and terraces are there to enjoy a pleasant break.

MOBIMETROPOLE

The Métropole Aix-Marseille-Provence and RTM provide the public, on request, with a minibus with driver for intra-urban travel at €0.80 per journey and inter-urban travel at €2.10 per journey.

Terms of use: users must reside within the metropolitan area, users must possess a card showing a disability level of at least 80%, issued by the Maison Départementale des Personnes Handicapées, users must compile documents to be approved by the Mobimétropole access commission.
